

## Do you want to improve your dance technique and get feedback, in a short series of very focused classes?



The RSCDS Dancing Achievement Award (DAA) involves a series of four or five classes, working intensively on technique, and mastering some specific formations and dances. Then a trained Assessor and one local teacher watch the class dance as a team, and give *individuals* feedback on their proficiency.

Our first go at the DAA would probably be Intermediate level, but there are also Advanced and Very Advanced levels. **You don't have to be expert to join the class, and you absolutely don't have to be a teacher or even interested in teaching; you just have to want to work on your dancing.**
