

- 1c long cast to 3pl while (4) 3c set | dance up to 1pl; repeat the figure (1,2,3)
- 9-1c cross below 2c, cast behind 3c (2c up) and lead up to 1cnrs; set to 1cnrs, to 2cnrs, finish 2plx in middle facing down



- 1c dance between 3c, cross and cast up to 2pl, 2c dance in on [20]; 2c+1c ½Poussette (1,2,3) 17-
- 25-1c+2c Allemande (2,1,3)

- 17-1c, 1W leading, cast off 2 and cross (2c up); 1W cast up as 1M dances up | 2c+1c ½ LHA (1,2,3),
- 25-1c+2c Poussette (2,1,3)



- 9-1c lead down below 2c, cross and cast round 3c; dance up to the top, cast to face 1cnrs (2c up)
- 1c turn corner, P, corner, P to finish 17between corners
- 25-2c+1c+3c A&R; 1c turn BH 11/2





1c dance to top and cast off; all turn P RH (2,1,3) 25-

- 1c cross RH | cast off two (2c+3c up); 3c+1c RHA
- 9-1c lead to top, cross and cast to 2pl (3c down); 2c+1c LHA (2,1,3)
- 17-32 2c+3c ("corners") set and change place RH four times following the track of R&L (3M&2W make polite turns) while{16} 1c cross (across or up/dn) RH and cast R round the corner four times.





Note by the deviser in TacTalk of jan. 1986: on [17–32] the corners set "as written"; they do not split the setting as is customary in "J.B. Milne".

- 1-1c (1W leading) cast off | dance across to 2plx (2c up); turn 2c on sides EH
- 9-1c (1W leading) cast off | dance across to 3pl (3c up); turn 3c on sides EH (2,3,1)
- 17-1c set | dance up to 2pl centre BtoB facing own sides (3c down); 1/2 DTr
- 1c dance RSh to 1cnrs (to 2,1,3); all 25turn P RH (2,1,3)



- 9-16 Set+Link for 3, 1s dance round each other RSh to 1M facing down, 1L facing up & turn R about about to end BtoB (1M facing 3s at top, 1L facing 2s in 3rd place)
- All set as Double Triangles, 1s petronella turn to end 1L between 3s (at top)/1M between 2s & all Set+Link for 3 to end 3 1 2
- **25-32** All set & cross RH & chase 1/2 way. 2 1 3

- 9- 1c & 1cnrs set, 1c advancing to end BtoB | 1c turn corner BH; open into circle4 L, ending with 1cnrs in places and 1W+2c & 1M+3c forming lines across
- 17- 1c repeat with 2cnrs, to finish between corners
- 25- Lsh Reels3(6) on opposite sides with cnrs | 1c cross to own side



- **17-** 2c+1c R&L
- 25- 1c dance between 3c | cast up; dance up between 2c | cast off to (2,1,3)





- 1- 1c turn RH | cast (2c up); turn LH to face 1cnrs
- 9- 1c ½Reel4 with 1cnrs (pass P Lsh); Repeat with 2cnrs
- 17- Repeat with 3cnrs (1cnr person); Repeat with 4cnrs (2cnr person)
- 25- 1W+2c & 1M+3c Reels3 across, Lsh to 1cnr
- 33- 2c+1c+3c circle6 and back



Note: Cosh explicitly tells 1c to pass Lsh in [9-24]; however the Rsh pass is quite common, and sometimes nicknamed "Mairi's Divorce".
